## November Mexico Outreach Report- 3 Villages Impacted!

Our COC team was 50 strong from Canada, Montana, Louisiana, Oregon and mostly California. We accomplished much promoting two of the new works – San Vicente and San Ignacio. The San Ignacio Mission is very close to a dangerous cult. Every thing that La Fuente does is very well done and established.



**Bucerias:** Our construction team of 20 worked very hard, pouring cement for the sanctuary stage and pouring huge footings for the large sanctuary with a 75 foot wide steel beam. Many large tiles were laid, and a plethora of painting was done.

**San Vicente & San Ignacio:** We provided dental, medical and eyeglasses to both villages. The children's program was a huge success, ministering to over 500 children between both days.

## Another Opportunity for a 10k Matching Grant to Finish the Roof!

We want to share an incredible opportunity with you that will be a great help to our work in Mexico. The same anonymous donor made another large gift of \$10,000 to finish the roof on the church. They challenged us to match the donation. The whole cost of the roof is \$35,000.



Three years ago La Fuente Riviera started with 10 plastic chairs, a flannel graph and a guitar under a tree. Now, every week over 300 people attend church and more than 500 people are being ministered to in the various missions and outreach activities.
